

Hunt Booking Contract

I, _____, contract with Frontier Adventures LLC to arrange a hunt in Alaska, including hunting, guiding, outfitting and transportation to the extent described below. Due to the remote area of this trip, weather and flight delays are possible. Frontier Adventures LLC is not responsible for additional costs, or hunting days lost, due to these delays. Alaska hunting license and big game tag are not included. The species to be hunted is _____.

The cost of the hunt is _____. I understand that this is for a single species / combination (circle one) hunt. This price includes (a) one flight to and one flight from camp, (b) fully outfitted and stocked camp, (c) all meals while in the field, (d) trophy care in field, (e) care of meat in the field, (f) professional licensed guide, and (g) private and federal land use fees. The price does not include (a) airfare to/from Alaska, (b) lodging before and after the hunt, (c) hunting license, (d) big game tag(s), (e) meat and trophy processing, (f) trophy shipping and expediting, (g) meat shipping from origin of hunt, and (h) taxidermy fees.

Additional animals can be added on a trophy fee basis as follows:

Black Bear	\$1,500
Caribou	\$1,500
Brown/Grizzly Bear	\$6,000

Trophy fees must be collected prior to the entering the field. If the additional animal is not harvested, the fee will be returned at end of hunt.

A 50% deposit is due when booking a hunt that will occur within one year of the date of booking. The remainder is due 60 days prior to the hunt. If booking a hunt that will occur more than one year from the date of booking, a \$2000 deposit will be due when the hunt is booked. A 50% deposit will be due on January 1 of the calendar year in which the hunt will occur. The remainder is due 60 days prior to the hunt. I understand that if I cancel the hunt, all amounts paid as deposits or otherwise will be forfeited.

If an animal is wounded or lost, it is your animal to hunt for the duration of the hunt. No additional same species trophy may be taken if the wounded animal is not found. The trophy will be considered harvested. The only exception occurs in units where two bears per person are allowed. In that case, taking of a second bear will result in an additional trophy fee. If the first animal is wounded but not recovered, a trophy fee will still be required for a second animal taken.

The hunt will start on ____ and end on _____, unless the species is taken prior to that date. Once the designated species is taken, the hunt is complete, unless the hunter arranged to hunt on a trophy fee basis. Additional days of hunting after the planned end date may be purchased if guide's schedule allows.

Any disputes arising out of this contract shall be heard in Anchorage, Alaska. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the state of Alaska, without respect to its conflict of laws provisions.
